



Our dedicated Career Development Center works with you to understand your company culture and identify the best talent for your immediate and future needs. Please find below an overview of the different touchpoints companies have with MBAs throughout the year.

Program timetable

The IMD MBA runs from January to December.

Summer internship

Students have the opportunity to do an 8-week career-enhancing internship (embedded in the program) from July 7th to August 29. Companies advertise internships and/or present on campus January through June.

Student club activities

Student clubs organise sector and company insight activities, either through standalone presentations or topic panels.

International Consulting Project

Companies can hire a team of MBAs for 5 weeks in October / November to execute consulting projects agreement provided by IMD.

Full-time recruitment

Students are ready to begin fulltime roles starting mid-December.

Many of our recruiting partners post job openings in the second half of the year and engage with students, either on campus or virtually, between late August and November.
